Rules for this show:

1. No Smoking/Alcohol on the show grounds
2. Dogs must be on a leash, attached to a human.
3. Coggins and proof of Rabies vaccine (within one year of the show date) required for all horses. Do not unload without them.
4. Formal riding attire is NOT required. However, ASTM/SEI helmets and boots with a heel are required in all classes, English and Western.
5. Divisions are open to all ages (unless otherwise stated), based on rider’s current level of ability, may be split if more than 12 riders in the division. Adult horse WTC or WJL will be open to all adult riders and horses look to show without competing against juniors or beginner adults riders.
- 6: DEFINITIONS: Assisted WT, diagonals do NOT count, the leader is encourage NOT to steer but be there as a safety precaution. Beginner WT or Jog, diagonals do NOT count. Advanced WT or J, diagonals DO count; Beginner WTC or JL, individual or small group canters, leads do NOT count; Advanced WTC or JL, group canters, leads DO count (may be split by age or seat if more than 8 riders in division); Adult Horse WTC or JL, for open to all level adult riders and horses looking to show without competing against juniors or beginner adults riders.
- JUMPING DIVISIONS: Beginner WT, Ground Poles – all age riders uncomfortable with group canters; Beginner WTC, Cross Rails – 6” maximum – all age riders comfortable with group canters (MAY NOT cross-enter Beginner WTC, Ground Poles) Trotting between fences will NOT be penalized in Beginner WTC jumping classes.; Intermediate Beginner WTC, 12” maximum – all age riders comfortable with group canters and jumping verticals; Advance Beginner WTC, 2’ maximum – all age riders comfortable with group canters and more challenging fences (courses may include a combination).
7. CHAMPION AND RESERVE CHAMPION RIBBONS FOR EACH DIVISION – Points are awarded 7-5-4-3-2-1
8. The show manager reserves the right to combine, split, or cancel any classes as necessary.
